Complete these three requirements:

- ___ Make a list of common materials used to create visual art compositions.
- ___ Demonstrate how six of the following elements of design are used in a drawing: lines, circles, dots, shapes, colors, patterns, textures, space, balance, or perspective.
- ___ Identify the three primary colors and the three secondary colors that can be made by mixing them. Show how this is done using paints or markers. Use the primary and secondary colors to create a painting.

REQUIREMENTS FOR THE ART ACADEMICS PIN

- ___ Required: Belt loop previously earned (or all three of the above requirements checked).

Complete six of the following requirements:

- ___ Visit an art museum, gallery, or exhibit. Discuss with an adult the art you saw.
- ___ Create two self-portraits using two different art techniques, such as drawing, painting, printmaking, sculpture, or computer illustration.
- ___ Demonstrate how to make paper. Make a sample at least 4 inches by 4 inches.
- ___ Make a simple silkscreen or stencil. Print a card or T-shirt.
- ___ Create a freestanding sculpture or mobile using wood, metal, soap, papier-mâché, or found objects.
- ___ Create an object using clay that can be fired, baked in the oven, or hardened in water.
- ___ Photograph four subjects in one theme, such as landscapes, people, animals, sports, or buildings.
- ___ Make a collage using several different materials.
- ___ Use your artistic skills to create a postage stamp, book cover, or music CD cover.
- ___ Use a computer illustration or painting program to create a work of art.
- ___ Display your artwork in a pack, school, or community art show.
