Responsibilities:

- Have a good working knowledge of the Tiger Cub Scout program.
- Set up meetings at the beginning of the year for new Tiger Cub Scouts and their parents. Assist the boys in earning their bobcat badge.
- Recruit a leader for the Tiger Cub Scout Den.
- Assist leader in recruiting Tiger Cub partners for den activities.
- Provide support to Tiger Cub leader.
- Assist Tiger Cub leader with any questions he or she may have.
- Assist the Webelos leaders with implementing a good program for their Webelos Scouts.
- Probably will not need to attend den meetings after leader is trained.
- May act as a substitute leader when needed.
